DALTON'S DRESS CODE

The below Dalton standards help ensure a safe, distraction-free learning environment for all of our students. Students in violation of this dress code will be asked to call their parents for appropriate clothing to be brought to school.

Our dress code specifies the following:

- Clothing that does not adequately cover the body and is worn in such a way as that undergarments can be seen, is not allowed.
- Shorts, dresses, skirts that are so short as to be immodest and/or create a distraction and are not as long as the child's fingertip reach, will not be allowed.
- Shirts or dresses with spaghetti straps, tank tops, halter or tube tops will not be allowed.
- Shirts and blouses must be long enough so that neither skin nor navel shows.
- Pants and skirts must be worn at the waistline (no sagging).
- Any clothing with suggestive, offensive or violent language or pictures will not be allowed.
- Hats, visors, bandanas or doo rags may not be worn anywhere on the body or inside the building.
- Shoes must be safe and worn at all times. "Flip-flop" type shoes are not to be worn, they are difficult on the gravel playground and hard to run in.
- Hair may not be dyed or sprayed an unnatural color.
- We ask that all makeup, perfume, fingernail products, and hair products be used only at home. These products will be taken away from students and returned to parents at the end of the school day.
